INTERSTATE CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

1. I-95 from south of Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- Three northbound lanes of I-95 will be closed Monday through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. The first lane will close at 10:30 p.m., the second lane at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane at 12:30 a.m. until 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.
- Three southbound lanes of I-95 will be closed Monday through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. The first lane will close at 10:30 p.m., the second lane closing at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane closing at 12:30 a.m. until 5 a.m. All lanes will be open by 5:30 a.m.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed as needed Monday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via Commercial Boulevard.
- **Advance Notice:** The I-95 northbound entrance ramps from Broward Boulevard will be closed as needed Monday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via the Broward Boulevard Park & Ride lot and northbound I-95.
- **Advance Notice:** The I-95 northbound entrance ramps from Broward Boulevard will be fully closed from 11 p.m. Saturday, September 30 through 5 a.m. Monday, October 2. Traffic will be detoured via the Broward Boulevard Park & Ride lot and northbound I-95.
- **Advance Notice:** The I-95 southbound entrance ramps from Commercial Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m., beginning Sunday, October 1 through Thursday, October 12.

Traffic will be detoured via Powerline Road, Oakland Park Boulevard and I-95.

- **Advance Notice:** The I-95 southbound exit ramp to Oakland Park Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m., beginning Sunday, October 1 through Thursday, October 12. Traffic will be detoured via Sunrise Boulevard and I-95.
- **Advance Notice:** The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Sunrise Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m., beginning Sunday, October 1 through Thursday, October 12. Traffic will be detoured via Oakland Park Boulevard and I-95.
- **Advance Notice:** The I-95 northbound entrance ramps from Sunrise Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m., beginning Sunday, October 1 through Thursday, October 12. Traffic will be detoured via Oakland Park Boulevard and I-95.

Description: This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from south of Broward Boulevard to north of Commercial Boulevard in Broward County. The scope of work includes adding a lane and converting the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes to create two express lanes in each direction. Other work includes: installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment; widening bridges; and installing noise barrier walls at locations along I-95 Southbound between Broward Boulevard and NW 6th Street, and along I-95 Northbound between Powerline Road and Commercial Boulevard. Cost/Completion: Construction cost is \$149 million. Completion is expected in spring 2020.

2. I-95 from north of Commercial Boulevard in Fort Lauderdale to south of SW 10th Street in Deerfield Beach

Traffic Impact:

- Three northbound lanes of I-95 between Commercial Boulevard and SW 10th Street will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The first lane will close at 10:30 p.m., the second lane at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane at 12:30 a.m. until 5:30 a.m.
- Three southbound lanes of I-95 between SW 10th Street and Commercial Boulevard will be closed Sunday through Thursday night between 10:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. The first lane will close at 10:30 p.m., the second lane at 11:30 p.m. and the third lane at 12:30 a.m. until 5:30 a.m.
- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to westbound Atlantic Boulevard is completely closed through fall 2017. Traffic is detoured to a temporary ramp just south of the closed ramp.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramp to westbound Cypress Creek Road will be closed as needed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Atlantic Boulevard.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramp to eastbound Cypress Creek Road will be closed as needed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Atlantic Boulevard.

- The I-95 northbound entrance ramp from westbound Cypress Creek Road will be closed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via North Dixie Highway and Commercial Boulevard.
- The I-95 northbound exit ramp to Atlantic Boulevard will be closed as needed Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and Copans Road.
- All lanes in both directions of Sample Road at I-95 may be closed intermittently Sunday through Thursday between 11:30 p.m. and 5 a.m. Traffic will be detoured via I-95 and SW 10th Street.
- One lane in each direction of Martin Luther King Boulevard from NW 12th Avenue to NW 10th Avenue will be closed Monday through Friday between 4 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- Two lanes in each direction of Sample Road from Military Trail to N. Dixie Highway will be closed as needed Sunday through Thursday night between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
- One lane in each direction of Sample Road from Military Trail to N. Dixie Highway will be closed Tuesday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- One lane in each direction of Atlantic Boulevard from Andrews Avenue to N. Dixie Highway will be closed Tuesday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m.

Description: This project will extend the High Occupancy Toll lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard to south of SW 10th Street in Broward County. The scope of work includes adding a lane and converting the High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) lanes to create two express lanes in each direction. Other work includes: installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and tolling equipment; widening bridges; and installing noise barrier walls at locations along I-95 northbound between Atlantic Boulevard and Sample Road, and along I-95 southbound north of Sample Road. Contract time for this \$154 million project began **Friday, January 8, 2016**, with design activities currently underway. Construction began Sunday, August 14, 2016. Cost/Completion: Construction cost is \$154 million. Completion is expected in spring 2020.

3. I-95 Interchange from Hillsboro Boulevard to SW 10th Street

Traffic Impact:

- The I-95 southbound exit ramp to SW 10th Street will be fully closed as needed Sunday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. through November. Motorists can detour via Hillsboro Boulevard.
- The outside lanes of I-95 southbound from Hillsboro Boulevard to SW 10th Street will be closed Monday through Friday with the first lane closing at 9 p.m., the second lane closing at 10 p.m. and the third lane, if necessary, closing at 12:30 a.m. until 5 a.m. through November.
- Two westbound lanes of SW 10th Street at I-95 will be closed Monday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m. through November.
- The sidewalk on the north side of SW 10th Street between SW 12th Avenue and SW Natura Boulevard is closed through November 2017. Signs are in place to direct pedestrians to the south sidewalk.

Description: Construction on this 1.5-mile project began Monday, January 26, 2015. Work consists of widening southbound I-95 to add an auxiliary lane from the Hillsboro Boulevard entrance ramp to the SW 10th Street exit ramp, widening the existing southbound I-95 exit ramp to SW 10th Street, addition of a free flow right turn lane to westbound SW 10th Street, widening of westbound SW 10th Street to add an acceleration lane, utility relocation, milling and resurfacing, bridge widening, installation of barrier walls, curbs, sidewalks, guardrail, drainage, overhead signs, signing and pavement markings, signals, lighting, and retaining walls. This is the first of five interchange improvement projects throughout Broward and Palm Beach Counties. Cost/Completion: Construction cost for all five projects is \$32.5 million. Completion in fall 2017.

4. **I-75 from NW 170th Street in Miami-Dade County to I-595 in Broward County**

Traffic Impact:

- **Segment A & B (NW 170th Street in Miami-Dade County to South of Miramar Parkway in Broward County)**
 - Two southbound lanes of I-75 from Miami Gardens Drive to NW 170th Street will be closed Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - Two southbound lanes of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to Miami Gardens Drive will be closed Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - Two southbound lanes of I-75 from Miramar Parkway to Florida's Turnpike will be closed Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - Two northbound lanes of I-75 from Florida's Turnpike to Miramar Parkway will be closed Monday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - Two northbound lanes of I-75 from Miami Gardens Drive to Florida's Turnpike will be closed Monday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - Two northbound lanes of I-75 from NW 170th Street to Miami Gardens Drive will be closed Monday through Thursday between 8 p.m. and 4 p.m.
 - One lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from Red Road to I-75 will be closed Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - One lane in each direction of Florida's Turnpike from I-75 to Okeechobee Road will be closed Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - One northbound ramp lane of Florida's Turnpike from Okeechobee Road to I-75 will be closed Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.

- One southbound ramp lane of I-75 from Snake Creek Canal to Florida's Turnpike will be closed Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- One lane in each direction of I-75 from NW 170th Street to Florida's Turnpike will be closed Monday through Thursday between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- Three southbound lanes of I-75 from Miramar Parkway to Florida's Turnpike will be closed Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Three northbound lanes of I-75 from Miramar Parkway to Florida's Turnpike will be closed Monday through Thursday between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- The Bass Creek Bridge between SW 160th Avenue/Dykes Road and SW 148th Avenue may be closed Monday through Friday between 9 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Motorists east of Bass Creek Bridge will be detoured east on SW 48th Court/Bass Creek Road to SW 148th Avenue, north on SW 148th Avenue to Miramar Parkway, west on Miramar Parkway to SW 160th Avenue/Dykes Road, and south on SW 160th Avenue/Dykes Road to re-enter SW 48th Court/Bass Creek Road. Motorists west of Bass Creek Bridge will be detoured west on SW 48th Court/Bass Creek Road to SW 160th Avenue/Dykes Road, north on SW 160th Avenue/Dykes Road to Miramar Parkway, east on Miramar Parkway to SW 148th Avenue, and south on SW 148th Avenue to re-enter SW 48th Court/Bass Creek Road. The work is expected to be completed in January 2018.
- **Segment C (South of Miramar Parkway to South of Sheridan Street)**
 - One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to north of Miramar Parkway will be closed daily between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.
 - One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to north of Miramar Parkway will be closed daily between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m.
 - One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Pines Boulevard to north of Pines Boulevard will be closed daily between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m.
 - One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Pines Boulevard to north of Pines Boulevard may be closed daily between 10 a.m. and 5 p.m.
 - One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Pines Boulevard to north of Pines Boulevard will be closed nightly between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m.
 - One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Pines Boulevard to north of Pines Boulevard will be closed nightly between 7 p.m. and 7 a.m.
 - One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to north of Miramar Parkway will be closed nightly between 8 p.m. and 3 p.m.
 - One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to north of Miramar Parkway will be closed daily between 10 a.m. and 7 a.m.
 - One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed daily between 10 a.m. and 2 p.m.

- One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed daily between 11 a.m. and 3 p.m.
- One northbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed nightly between 9 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- One southbound lane of I-75 from south of Miramar Parkway to Miramar Parkway will be closed nightly between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- One lane in either direction of Miramar Parkway at I-75 will be closed nightly between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- **Segment D (South of Sheridan Street to North of Griffin Road)**
 - One lane in each direction of I-75 from south of Sheridan Street to north of Griffin Road may be closed daily between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m.
 - Two lanes in either direction of I-75 from south of Sheridan Street to north of Griffin Road may be closed nightly between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - One lane in each direction of Sheridan Street at I-75 may be closed daily between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m.
 - Two lanes in either direction of Sheridan Street at I-75 may be closed nightly between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.
 - Three lanes in each direction of I-75 from north of Griffin Road to south of Sheridan Street will be closed nightly between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m.
 - The I-75 northbound exit ramp to westbound Sheridan Street (Exit 11B) may be closed Monday through Thursday between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists will be detoured to exit at Sheridan Street East (Exit 11A), continue east on Sheridan Street to Flamingo Road and make a U-turn to go west.
 - The I-75 southbound exit ramp to eastbound Sheridan Street (Exit 11) may be closed Monday through Thursday between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists will be detoured to exit at westbound Sheridan Street, continue west on Sheridan Street to SW 162nd Avenue and make a U-turn to go east.
 - The I-75 northbound exit ramp to westbound Griffin Road (Exit 13B) will be closed intermittently Monday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists will be detoured to exit at Sheridan Street East (Exit 11), continue east on Sheridan Street to Flamingo Road and north on Flamingo Road to Griffin Road.
 - The I-75 southbound exit ramp to eastbound Griffin Road (Exit 13A) may be closed intermittently Monday through Thursday between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Motorists will be detoured to exit at Griffin Road West (Exit 13B), continue west on Griffin Road to Dykes Road and make a U-turn at Dykes Road to go east.
- **Segment E (North of Griffin Road to I-595)**
 - Two lanes in each direction of I-75 from South Post Road to Indian Trace will be closed Monday through Thursday between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m.

- **Northbound Lane Balancing Project (Indian Trace to I-595)**

- All lanes are open through Friday, September 22.

Description: This 15-mile project will add four tolled managed lanes in the I-75 median from NW 170th Street in northern Miami-Dade County to I-595 in Broward County. The work will be completed in four segments to minimize the impact to the public. This project includes entrance and exit access points to the express lanes; a bridge with a direct connection to 595 Express; integrated Intelligent Transportation System and tolling components; noise barrier walls at various locations and new signage, lighting, drainage and landscaping improvements. Cost/Completion: Construction cost is \$485 million. Completion in early 2019.

NORTHEAST BROWARD CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

5. A1A Improvements Project from Oakland Park Boulevard to Flamingo Avenue in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of A1A from Oakland Park Boulevard to Flamingo Avenue may be closed intermittently at any time Sunday evening through Friday morning for resurfacing and final pavement markings.
- Access between A1A and Galt Ocean Drive at NE 32nd Street, NE 35th Street, NE 36th Street, NE 40th Street and NE 41st Street and the northern exit from Galt Ocean Drive to A1A may be closed daytime or nighttime for approximately three hours for paving at the intersections through late September.

Description: Project improvements include removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway within the project limits; upgrading sidewalks and ramps to meet ADA requirements; repairing, adjusting, and replacing drainage structures throughout the project limits; upgrading the following existing intersections to mast arm signals: 34th Street, mid-block between 36th and 40th Street, and at 40th Street; upgrading all existing pedestrian signals to countdown timers; upgrading signs and pavement markings throughout the project limits, including adding a 1.5 foot striped buffer to separate the four foot wide bike lanes from the outside vehicle travel lane; upgrading existing lighting along the corridor to lighting with a variable intensity function that can be accessed remotely in order to cause minimal disruption to sea turtles during their nesting season; adding elevated roadway lighting and lower level lighting to illuminate the sidewalk, and adding a business access drive aisle along the east side of road between NE 34th and NE 36th Street. Cost/Completion: \$9.3 million. Completion in summer 2017.

6. Broward Boulevard Improvements and Bridge Replacement Project in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- Westbound traffic is shifted slightly north and will use the three-lane temporary bridge for the duration of construction.

- Eastbound traffic is shifted slightly north to the newly-constructed north side of the bridge through fall 2017 while crews construct the south side of the bridge.
- Up to two lanes in each direction of Broward Boulevard from US 1 to NW 18th Avenue will be closed between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. and Saturdays between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. for drainage improvements, roadway widening, curb and gutter installation and sidewalk construction. The closures will be limited to a maximum of 500 feet at a time.
- The sidewalk along the north side of Broward Boulevard from NW 18th Avenue to NW 15th Avenue is closed. Detour signs are in place to guide pedestrians.
- The sidewalk along the north side of Broward Boulevard from US 1 to NW 14th Avenue is closed for utility improvements. Signs are in place to direct pedestrians to the south sidewalk as needed.
- The outside lane in each direction of the cross streets on either side of Broward Boulevard from NW 3rd Avenue / Nugent Avenue to NW 11th Avenue may be closed Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. for the installation of traffic signal foundations on Broward Boulevard. Crews will only work at one cross street at a time.
- Access between SW 15th Terrace and Broward Boulevard is closed through fall 2017. Detour signs are in place to guide motorists to SW 14th Avenue to access SW 15th Terrace.

Description: Project improvements include replacing the bridge over the North Fork of the New River, removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway, upgrading crosswalk ramps to meet ADA requirements, upgrading signs and pavement markings, relocating bus shelters, adding roadway lighting, installing drainage structures, upgrading signalized intersections to mast arms, reconstructing sidewalks, and widening roadway to add bike lanes in each direction. 7. Hillsboro Boulevard Improvements Project from Military Trail to US 1 in Deerfield Beach

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of Hillsboro Boulevard from Military Trail to US 1 may be closed for sidewalk, drainage and signal improvements and sign installation.
- Up to two lanes in each direction of Hillsboro Boulevard from Military Trail to US 1 will be closed nightly between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m. through Tuesday, October 31 for resurfacing, sidewalk improvements and other construction work.
- The outside lane of westbound Hillsboro Boulevard from NW 1st Avenue Military Trail will be closed through September for drainage, widening, signal and sidewalk improvements.

Description: Project improvements include improving the off-ramp from northbound I-95 to eastbound Hillsboro Boulevard including adding a new signalized intersection and adding second lane to increase capacity; relocating and upgrading drainage structures; upgrading crosswalk ramps to meet ADA requirements; constructing new stamped asphalt crosswalks from east of Natura Boulevard to US 1; upgrading existing pedestrian signals to countdown timers; upgrading signalized intersections to mast arms; installing new decorative lighting; constructing new medians east of SE 2 Avenue; and removing old asphalt and resurfacing the roadway. In addition, signs and pavement markings will be upgraded to reflect the new roadway configuration: from Military Trail to Dixie Highway, there will be three 11-foot travel lanes in each direction; from NE / SE 2 Avenue to US 1, there will be two 11-foot lanes in each direction. Also, bike lanes or sharrows (symbols to designate the outside travel lane will be shared by vehicles and bicycles) will be added as follows: from Military Trail to NW/SW 2 Terrace, there will be a 4-foot-wide bike lane; from NW / SW 2 Terrace to NE / SE 2 Avenue, sharrows in the outside travel lane will designate a shared lane; from NE / SE 2 Avenue to US 1, there will be a 7-foot-wide bike lane. 8. Broward Mobility Project

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of NW 11th Avenue from north of Broward Boulevard to east of NW 3rd Court will be closed Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. for drainage work.
- Traffic lanes on SW 31st Avenue from Riverland Road to SW 14th Street will be narrowed and traffic may be shifted toward the center of the road Monday through Friday between 9 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. for shoulder widening and drainage installation. One lane will be open in each direction.

Description: The improvements under this contract include constructing sidewalks, multi-use pedestrian paths, and bicycle lanes along 46 roadways in Broward County within Hollywood, Pembroke Pines, Davie, Plantation, Deerfield Beach, Pompano Beach, Lauderhill, Oakland Park, Lauderdale Lakes, and Fort Lauderdale. 9. SE 17th Street at SE 15th Avenue Intersection Improvements Project in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- One lane in each direction of SE 17th Street at SE 15th Avenue may be closed Monday through Thursday night between 9 p.m. and 11:30 a.m. for signal improvements.

Description: The improvements under this contract include removing existing asphalt and resurfacing the intersection, installing a new signalized intersection with mast arms, adding crosswalks on both sides of the intersection to provide access across SE 17 Street, installing two new street lights at the intersection, and installing eight countdown pedestrian signals. Cost/Completion: \$413,333. Completion in summer 2017.

10. Old Dixie Highway Improvements Project from NE 13th Street to the Middle River Bridge in Fort Lauderdale

Traffic Impact:

- The northbound lane of Old Dixie Highway from NE 13th Court to the south end of the Middle River Bridge may be closed between 7:30 a.m. and 6 p.m. through Friday, October 27 for road widening, sign installation and landscaping. A flag crew will direct traffic and motorists can expect delays.
- The northbound lane of Old Dixie Highway from NE 13th Court to NE 18th Court may be closed Monday through Friday between 7:30 a.m. and 6 p.m. and Saturdays between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Flaggers will direct traffic through the work zone. Motorists can expect delays.
- “No Thru Trucks” signs have been installed along Old Dixie Highway at each end of the project limits – NE 13th Street in Fort Lauderdale and NE 11th Avenue in Wilton Manors – to enhance safety in the construction zone.
