



**NOTICE TO ALL CONSTRUCTION SITES CONCERNING
The City of Hollywood requirement for face masks or facial covering**

**The Building Official for the City of Hollywood now
declares that:**

*“Any and all persons, while within the interior of any and all essential services and business, as defined by Executive Order 20-91 issued by Governor DeSantis on April 1, 2020, as amended, and any and all persons while making deliveries or providing delivery services, are **required** to wear a form of covering over their nose and mouth at all times.”*

“This declaration describes a facial covering as a covering over the nose and mouth that may include a face mask, homemade mask, or other cloth covering, such as a scarf, bandana, handkerchief or other similar cloth covering.”

As related to construction sites, which also includes any work that is associated with a Building Permit requiring an inspection:

- All personnel on the site shall wear a mask or facial covering as described above, except when eating/drinking or where such mask or face covering would hinder the ability to safely communicate instructions or warnings.
- The CDC social distance radius of 6 feet shall be maintained.

City of Hollywood employees performing inspections have been instructed **NOT** to complete inspections where this order for face masks, facial coverings or proper social distancing is not being practiced.

We ask for your understanding and cooperation in enforcing the Governor’s Executive Order 20-91.
